Gulf Harbour Marina - Auckland

Overview

Gulpharbour is one of the main ramps north of Auckland, but can be unsafe in some weather conditions and be closed off without notice. So make sure you check the weather before heading out. There are two concrete ramps and a jetty, separated into launch & retrieve, to avoid long queues.

Parking

There is lots of parking around.

Facilities:

A beautifully maintained ramp in a precinct where you can find bait and tackle, as well as shops, cafes, marina berths to rent and a dry stack (\$20 a day). There is a frequent ferry from and to the Auckland CBD, rental car options are available.

The ramp has toilets and a dump station as well as rubbish bins.

You can find a self-service fuel dock with both petrol and diesel available for all boats, marina based and visitors. The fuel dock is located on the eastern side of the main channel. Instructions for use of the fuel pump are clearly posted on the fuel dock including payment methods. The fuel dock is operated by Go Fuel.
